SHAMLEY GREEN TREE INVENTORY INSPECTION AND ACTION REPORT

We are awaiting confirmation of the area to be covered in Lords Hill in order to complete the first check of the tree inventory (CH).

The first check of the inventory in the centre of Shamley Green was completed on 28th May. The revised table is below. I have checked a February 2002 History Society report on trees, by Michael Harding, which has confirmed some of the dates and species.

I have met the Pavias to discuss the two small horse chestnut trees, on the common outside Surrey House, which are unlikely to grow into trees of reasonable form as they are overshadowed by the mature limes. The conkers were originally planted by one of their children. They have in the past been cut by Waverley and regrown. One was planted following removal of a lime. An option is to prune them to keep them as small compact trees, another it to look at the possibility of moving the smaller on into a more central position where it has the opportunity to grow upwards.

We need to know what Waverley's plan is regarding the very tall lime trees. There is no sign of movement at the base; but there needs to be a plan to reduce longer term risks.

Sean Harrison has agreed to give a briefing later in the summer on what to look for regarding tree health. In the meantime we will photograph any fungi or query regarding foliage, recording the tree number and date.

Sean Harrison will visit in the next couple of weeks to comment on some trees on which there is a question. I will advise when, in case anyone wants to participate and learn.
